#### **2022 Student IRS Tax Filing Extension Approved**

Students who are required to file a 2022 U.S. federal tax return with the IRS, but have not yet filed due to an approved filing extension must check the box below and provide all documents listed.

- Copies of the student's (and spouse, if applicable) 2022 W-2 Form(s) or equivalent document(s) for each source of employment income.

#### **2022 Student Non-Tax Filers – Not Required to File**

Students (and spouse, if applicable) who are NOT required to file a 2022 U.S. federal tax return with the IRS must check the box below and provide all documents listed.

- Copies of the student's (and spouse, if applicable) 2022 W-2 Form(s) or equivalent document(s),
- A signed and dated statement certifying all of the following:
  - The student's name (and spouse, if married)
  - An affirmative statement to certify you (and spouse, if married) are not required to file a 2022 U.S. federal income tax return with the IRS, and
  - The source(s) and amounts of earnings, other income, and resources that supported the individual(s) for the 2022 tax year.
